Our Mission

The Faith and Football Summer League is more than a competition—it's a movement to inspire creativity, purpose, and growth in youth through the beautiful game. As a parent or guardian, you play a vital role in supporting a safe, respectful, and joyful environment where young athletes can thrive.

Code of Conduct for Parents & Guardians

To maintain a positive and respectful atmosphere for all participants:

- **Encouragement Only:** Cheer positively from the sidelines. No shouting instructions or criticizing players, coaches, or referees.
- **Respect All:** Treat all players, referees, coaches, staff, and other families with dignity and respect at all times.
- **Zero Tolerance for Disruption:** Any form of verbal abuse, aggressive behavior, or unsportsmanlike conduct may result in removal from the facility.
- **Let the Kids Play:** This is a space for players to express themselves without pressure. Trust the coaches and referees to manage the game.

League Format & Key Dates

- **Start Date:** Friday, July 11th
- **Game Nights:** Every **Friday from 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM**
- **Season Duration:** 10 weeks
- **Location:** Victory Athletic Center, Orange County
- **Ages Allowed:** Youth Division: 11-13 years old / Senior Division: 14+
- **Team Structure:**
 - 8 Teams
 - 7v7 Format
 - 12 players max per team
 - 2 coaches per team
- **Play Style:** No yelling, free play encouraged, and creative expression welcomed.

Registration & Assignments

- **Registration Deadline:** July 1st
- **Team Selection:** Players must select a team upon registration.
- **Draft Option:** If no team is selected, the player will be entered into a **random draft** and assigned a team by **July 10th**.
- **Fee Coverage Includes:**
 - Full player registration

- Official uniform
 - Referees and facility access
 - On-site staff support for all matches
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Ticket Types (For Families & Supporters)

- **General Player Ticket:** Grants participation and full access
 - **Sponsor-A-Player Ticket:** Covers full costs for two underserved players
 - **Big Time Ticket:** Sponsors an entire team of 12 players
 - **VIP Admission:** Includes access to exclusive areas, 1 food and drink voucher per Friday, and VIP amenities
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Facility Access & Logistics

- **Check-In:** Players should arrive 30 minutes before kickoff for check-in and warm-up.
 - **Parking:** Available on-site at Victory Athletic Center.
 - **Spectator Areas:** Clearly marked; VIP and general areas will be designated.
 - **Restrooms & Refreshments:** Facilities and concession access available each Friday.
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What to Bring

- Cleats (rubber only – no metal studs)
- Shin guards (mandatory)

- Water bottle (refill stations on-site)
- Positive attitude and sportsmanship!
